Dear Parents and Carers,

Uniform

As we approach warmer times we are keen to ensure that our high expectations of students, including their presentation, continue. For this reason, I am writing to ask for your help in making sure that your son/daughter comes to school in the correct uniform, reflecting the high standards that you, and we, expect.

In working with over 1000 teenagers, we have those who feel they are 'boiling' in mid-January, and those who insist on wearing a jumper on the warmest June day! We will therefore decide when to relax the uniform code. When the school determines that the weather is too warm to wear full uniform throughout the day, students will be permitted to remove their blazers by staff. Blazers should continue to be brought to school so that full uniform can be resumed if the weather changes. In very hot weather, as happened last year, we will relax uniform expectations further, on a day by day basis.

Our usual rules regarding footwear, piercings, etc. will remain in place throughout.
