## Catch up Strategy

### Catch up Intervention strategy – English Literacy

Year 7 will be split into two route ways for catch up. The students that didn't reach level 4 in their SATS will be split based on their levels and needs.

#### Route way 1

Students that scored level 2 or 3C in the SATS will receive a specialist catch-up literacy program during English lessons.

#### Route way 2

Students working on level 3B -3A will receive catch-up intervention in a series of after school and registration intervention sessions.

#### **Catch up Intervention strategy – Maths**

All students currently in year 7 and year 8 who didn't achieve level 4 at KS2 SATS to receive catch up during tailored Maths lessons.
